### Working in Japan

Koji Hatakeyama is a metalwork artist who lives and works in Japan. He makes cast bronze works of art and lidded boxes. The concept of 'as it is' in Japanese aesthetics is central to his creative process. Koji accepts and embraces the natural beauty formed by the molten bronze, acknowledging the distance between him and his creations.

Koji has exhibited widely in Japan and worldwide. His work is collected internationally, and it is represented in many major public collections including The National Museum of Modern Art, Tokyo, Japan; National Crafts Museum, Ishikawa, Japan; The Victoria and Albert Museum, London; The Ashmolean Museum of Art and Archaeology, Oxford; and The Metropolitan Museum of Art, New York, USA.
