My artistic goal is to shape an expression based on the wonderful phenomenon of nature rather than ceramics solely made by man's power. It is impossible, of course, to control the phenomenon completely. However, I see it as important for me to challenge nature and to pursue the possibilities of artistic control. It is my ambition to explore the beauty that comes from the fusion between man's creativity and nature's power.
